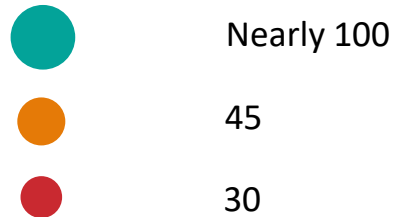

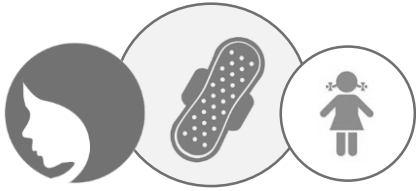

Achievements from the Ground

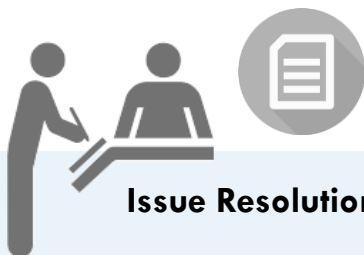


Menstrual Hygiene, Hygiene and School sanitation

- 300 women and adolescent girls capacitated and oriented by the GF and Mahila Arogya Samiti (MAS) members
- 150 children of 3 municipal schools educated on hand washing and personal hygiene
- Child cabinet set up in Rani Nagar and Ferrer Colony, Anantapur

Solid Waste Management & Disease Prevention

- GSG, MEPMA, and GFs have declared model lanes and streets in the slums for waste segregation and proper maintenance of drains
- The experience of GFs in segregating waste is being shared with other slums
- 30 campaigns on disease prevention conducted in Anantapur, 25 in Narsapur and 30 15 campaigns in Kovvur



Issue Resolution

- 998 out of 1011 issues on sanitation, health and hygiene resolved in Anantapur, 204 out of 235 in Narsapur and 230 out of 250 in Kovvur .
- These issues were collectively addressed by the ULB, MEPMA and the Community through the Gender Forums

FSSM

- 238 GF members trained on FSSM by experts
- 30 GF members are now master trainers who are training Slum Level Federation and Town Level Federation members



Toilet-Community, Public and Household

- Gender Sub-Group is supporting the community in applying for Individual Household Latrine (IHHL) subsidy in all three towns
- Excluded groups have started accessing IHHL (25 families) in Anantapur
- In Narsapur, 63 IHHL applications submitted and acknowledged by ULB. Sanction is underway
- Municipal Corporation and Community co-managing the Community Toilets in Rani Nagar, Anantapur

Resolutions passed

- ULBs and MEPMA have passed 20 resolutions in Anantapur, 10 in Kovvur and 10 in Narsapur to support the gender integration agenda in the cities
- Resolutions were on a)Construction of IHHLs b) Solid waste management, etc.
